Re-examination can be held at the expiration of three months. Any person obtaining a certificate from the board shall register the same at the health office, and shall then be allowed to practice the branch in which he has passed the examination; and no person shall commence the practice of medicine, surgery, or dentistry in the District who has not first obtained such a certificate. No person not a registered practitioner of medicine shall offer for sale any drug, nostrum, etc. , without first obtaining a certificate from the board setting forth that the said article may be offered for sale. Violations of the act are to be punished by a fine of not less than 20 nor more than 100, or by imprisonment for not less...
